



# EarthCents® New Home Resources for HERS Rater Participants

#### **HERS Raters**

The Georgia Power EarthCents® Program aims to significantly increase the market share of energy efficient new homes in the Georgia Power service territory. As the number of energy-efficient homes grows, so too will the demand for home energy ratings, creating a significant business opportunity for certified HERS service providers. Your support helps ensure that each home constructed by participating builders meets program requirements for energy efficiency, safety, quality, and comfort.

## **How to Participate as a Rater**

Certified home energy raters are integral participants in Georgia Power's EarthCents® New Homes Program. To qualify for EarthCents® rebates, builders must work with a RESNET-accredited HERS rater registered with the program.

### **Online Program Application**

To become an approved program rater, please complete the Georgia Power <u>Contractor Participation</u> <u>Application</u>.

#### **Online Rebate Application System**

After your application has been approved, you will be able to register pre-approved homes with the program and provide the required documentation by logging in to the <u>Online Rebate Application System</u>. You will need the email address and password you used when you completed your initial program application.

#### **Home Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible for rebates, projects must meet the following criteria:

- Homes and units must have electric service provided by Georgia Power and have a Georgia Power electric meter number.
- All space heating and water heating equipment must be electric.
- All New Home rebate projects require signed EarthCents® Builder Agreements. 2017 Agreements will require pre-approval by Georgia Power.
- HERS Rater must submit rebate application with supporting documentation for each home requesting a rebate.
