



Home Energy Improvement Program Information for Prospective Participating Contractors

Home Energy Improvement Program Contractors

Local home energy improvement contractors and assessors working through Georgia Power's Home Energy Improvement Program must maintain high standards of quality. As a Program Participating Contractor you will be required to undergo program training and complete projects that will be subject to periodic quality assurance inspections to verify that Georgia Power Home Energy Improvement Program projects are installed correctly.

Contractors interested in participating in Georgia Power's Home Energy Improvement Program and working on "Whole-House" projects, performing Home Energy Assessments and certain "Individual Improvement" projects must meet the certification guidelines of the Building Performance Institute (BPI) or Residential Energy Services Network (RESNET).

Program Participating Contractors use the "Whole-House" approach which the house is looked at as a system and customers are encouraged to perform a variety of measures to reduce overall electricity consumption including base load measures. Participating improvement contractors and assessors will be required to perform a thorough diagnostic Home Energy Assessment. Next, you will be required to provide customers with a report of cost-effective recommended home improvements. Finally, you will be required to inform the customer of available energy-efficiency incentives.

How to become a Program Participating Contractor

Program Participating Contractors are integral participants in Georgia Power's Home Energy Improvement Program. To qualify for Home Energy Improvement Program Whole House rebates, Georgia Power Customers must work with a RESNET-accredited HERS raters or BPI Building Analysts registered with the program.
